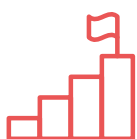




# Poland to ITU Council 2027-2030

Poland is committed to contributing to the global efforts on **promoting ICT solutions**, with ITU as the best platform to achieve this goal.



## **PROVEN ITU TRACK RECORD & ACHIEVEMENTS:**

ITU Council consistent member since 2010, Poland has been actively engaged within the ITU and as part of CEPT:

- Chair of the ITU Council Working Group - Internet
- Vice-chair of the ITU Council Working Group for Strategic and Financial Plans 2028-2031, CEPT Coordinator for key resolutions at WTDC-22, PP-22, WTSA-24, WTDC-25
- Women in ICT Champion - Regional representative and CEPT Coordinator for Resolution 55 on empowering women in ITU-T sector (WTSA-24)
- Vice-Chair of Committee 4 at WTDC-25
- Hosted CEPT Regional Meetings: COM ITU (2024), ECC (2022)
- Hosted ITU-T Study Group 5 meeting in Wrocław 2024 (192 global participants)

### **Poland has been engaged in international digital processes:**

- Hosts the annual WSIS Forum High Level Reception in Geneva
- Hosted the Internet Governance Forum 2021 in Katowice (over 10,000 registered participants from 175 countries, including over 2,700 participants onsite)





## **PROMOTING COOPERATION WITH AND WITHIN ITU:**

As the European Union Presidency in 2025, we promoted the importance of collaboration with ITU and its regions. Action was endorsed by the ITU management.



## **POLAND'S ACHIEVEMENTS IN THE FIELD OF DIGITAL TRANSFORMATION:**

- Access to connectivity offering 1 Gigabit per second (Gbps) for 77.4% of households
- Digital Wallet for Citizens (mObywatel) – nationwide mobile app and system providing digital access to official documents (such as electronic ID or driving licence) and public services
- ePayments platform – paperless, real-time and free payments for public services
- AI Factories Piast (Poznań) and Gaia (Kraków) – advancing AI research, fostering innovation and enabling industrial-scale AI applications
- Polish Large Language Model (PLLuM) – open-sourced AI model
- 3rd place in the European Commission's Open Data Maturity 2025 Report
- Champion in cybersecurity (6th in MIT's Cyber Defense Index), Tier 2 country in the ITU Global Cybersecurity Index 2024
