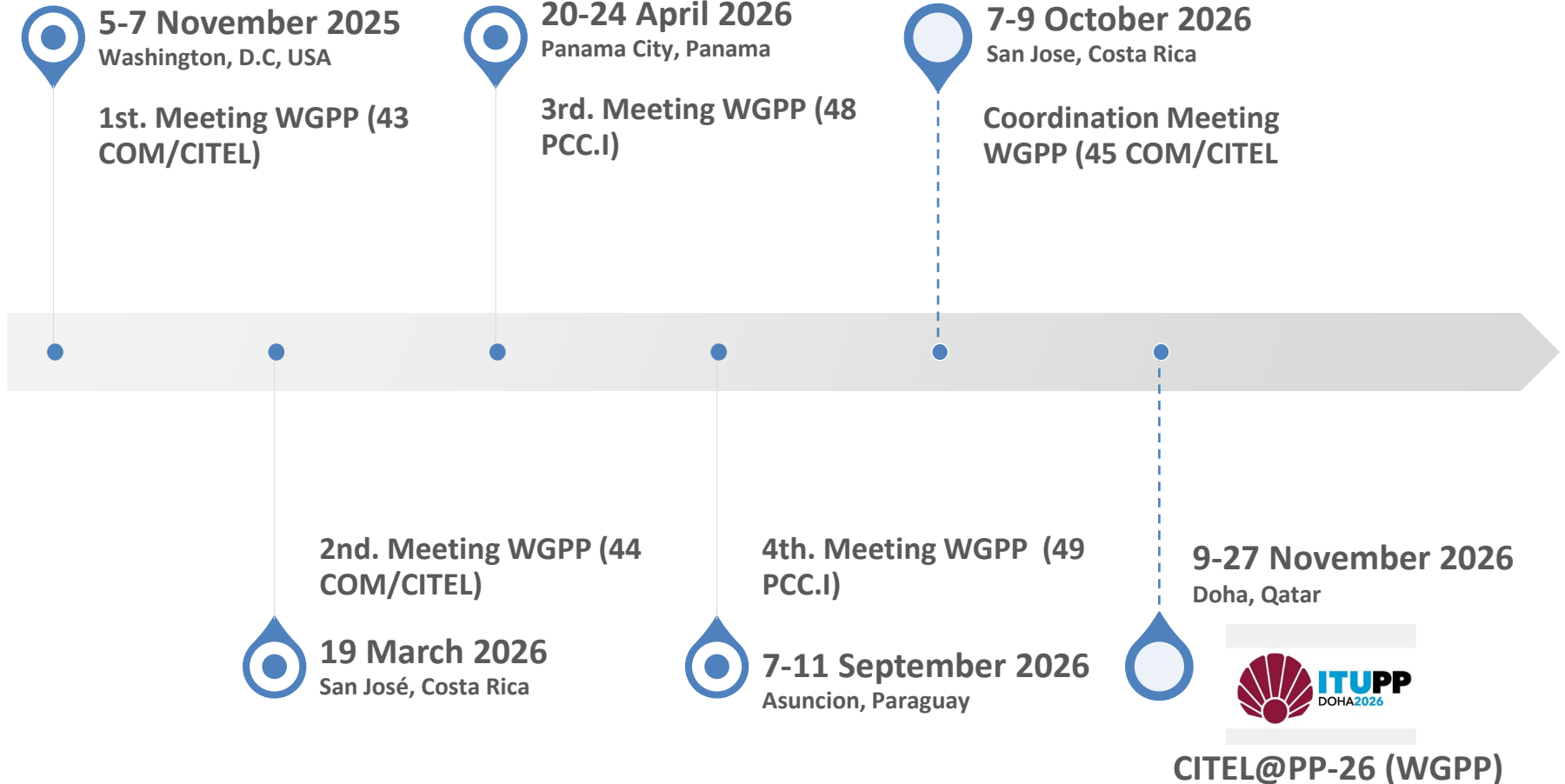
- CITELE WGPP preparation follows the structure of the Plenipotentiary Conference.

DEVELOPMENT INTER-AMERICAN PROPOSALS FOR PP-26

Preliminary Proposal: A **submission for discussion that one (1) Member State submits to WGPP** that has not received the support of any other Member State with a view to it becoming an INTER-AMERICAN PROPOSAL for future presentation during a particular ITU ASSEMBLY/CONFERENCE ASSEMBLY/CONFERENCE.

Draft Inter-American Proposal (DIAP): A PRELIMINARY PROPOSAL that, having been considered and discussed by the Member States, has the **support of more than one (1) administration.**

Inter-American Proposal (IAP): A DIAP, of which WGPP has completed its consideration and discussion and that has been **supported by no fewer than six (6) administrations** and is not opposed by more than 50% (fifty percent) of the number of supports obtained.
