

Romania - 156 years of ITU membership

Romania joined the ITU in 1866 and has significantly contributed to the ITU activities over the years. As a result, Romania's representatives often received the support of Member States for important functions in Plenipotentiary and World Conferences, as well as in ITU Study Groups and other meetings organised by the three Sectors of the Union - Radiocommunication, Standardisation and Development.

For seven consecutive terms, Romania has represented Region C in the ITU Council. This allowed our representatives to be actively involved in the elaboration of strategies for the global development of the ICT sector and to maintain a close collaboration with experts and specialists in the field.
